Earn a Visual & Performing Arts Certificate within any one specialty area (i.e. Art, Dance, Drama, or Music).

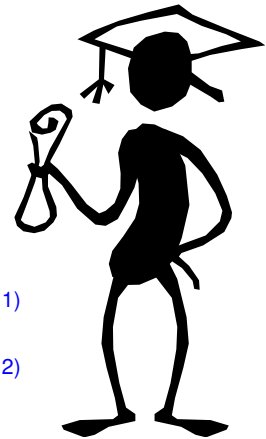
- Grade 8: One V.P.A. Course (i.e. Drama 8)

- Grade 8: One V.P.A. Course (i.e. Dance 8)
- Grade 9: One V.P.A. Course (i.e. Dance 9)
- Grade 10: One V.P.A. Course (i.e. Dance 10)
- Grade 11: Two or more V.P.A. Courses (i.e. Dance 11 & Acting 11)
- Grade 12: Two or more V.P.A. Courses (i.e. Dance 12 & Acting 12)
