This day grew out of survivor Phyllis Webstad's account of having her orange shirt taken away on her first day of school at the St. Joseph Mission Residential School in Williams Lake, B.C.

Orange Shirt Day is an opportunity for First Nations, local governments, schools, and communities to come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come.

There will be a group picture today at break outside the front of the school for all those donning an orange shirt or button today in honour of Aboriginal residential school survivors.
